Parking Instructions for Allan Hancock College

- ⇒ Coming from Santa Maria, go south on Hwy 101; take the Orcutt/Clark Ave.
- ⇒ Exit & go west (after the major intersection of Clark & Bradley,
- ⇒ Move into the west-bound left hand lane)
- ⇒ Continue on Clark, following the signs to Vandenberg AFB, & just after passing Jack in the Box on the left, immediately go under an overpass
- ⇒ At the light, immediately turn left & continue to Hwy. 1 (& 135) south
- ⇒ Follow signs to VAFB; when approaching the Base's main gate entrance, move into the left lane in preparation to turn left at the intersection
- ⇒ Proceed towards Lompoc on Hwy. 1;
- ⇒ Once past Vandenberg Village/Burton Mesa, stay in the right lane; slow & prepare to turn right at the light & intersection marking the entrance to Allan Hancock College's Lompoc Valley Center.
- ⇒ Proceed to parking (lots to the left or right, park in any yellow-striped spaces; or use 20-min. short-term parking on the circular drive). **Do not** park in posted fire lanes, at red-painted curbs, or in white-painted spaces.
- ⇒ Anyone w/ a license plate or placard indicating disabled, of course, can park in any parking space.
